

What is the first day of school?

The first full day of school is Thursday, Sept. 3.

Will we be able to meet my child's teacher before the first day of school?

Yes, we will have a Children's Open House on Sept. 2 & 3. During this time you and your child will have the opportunity to meet your teachers and learn a little bit about what the class will be doing this year. You will receive an invitation from your child's teacher the first week of August telling you what time during the morning to come and visit. Plan to spend about 45 minutes.

Will there be an informational meeting for new parents?

Yes, we will have a New Parent Open House on Monday, Aug. 31 at 6:30pm. During this time we will review key policies and procedures. This meeting will last about an hour and will be held in our Fellowship Hall.

When will lunch bunch begin?

Lunch bunch, from 12-1 each day, will start the first day of school. Lunch bunch is an optional choice for children of all ages. It's a great opportunity for the kids to share a meal with friends and play a little before they go home. Our typical schedule is to eat lunch until about 12:40 and then take children ages 3 and up to the playground. The younger children go to the old fellowship hall to play.

Please send foods your child can handle on his/her own. All fruits and veg, including grapes, must be cut into bite size pieces. Suggestions for lunch include sandwiches (cut in bite size pieces for younger children), crackers, cheese, small pieces of meat, cut up fruit and vegetables.

What is the cost for lunch bunch?

The regular cost for lunch bunch is \$4 per day. Our "All You Can Lunch Bunch" program offers a plan where you purchase a full month of lunch bunch for \$3 per day. The plan is non-refundable and cost varies month to month.

What types of supplies will I need to bring for school?

All children will need to bring a full change of clothes (including socks) in a labeled zip lock bag. Children in diapers will need to bring enough diapers for each day.

All children will be asked to donate the following : paper towels, wipes, foaming hand soap, hand sanitizer, Kleenex.

Babies – “Puffs” snack crackers

Toddlers – labeled sippy cup to leave at school.

2’s - glue sticks, washable markers

3’s - water color paints, glue sticks, washable markers

4’s – washable crayola markers (regular size), water color paints, glue sticks

5’s – washable crayola markers (regular size, package of 8, classic colors), crayola water colors in primary colors, glue sticks

Your child’s teacher may ask for additional contributions.

How will I drop off and pick up my child?

Our car line drop-off and pick-up system will begin on the first day of school. You will receive a car tag from your child’s teacher at Open House. For the car-line, you will enter from Kilpatrick (until the line gets short enough to enter from Country Club) and get in a line that will partially wrap around the building. Assistant teachers will greet your child at the car and take them to their class.

Walk-ins will need to enter from Country Club Rd and park in marked parking spaces.

If your child is experiencing separation anxiety (a very normal and typical reaction for young children 😊), we may suggest using the car-line. Our experience has shown that children who use the car line often have a shorter period of adjustment.
